Daniel Kieffer is the founder of the French "College of Holistic Naturopathy" CENATHO, of which he remains the pedagogical referent. An academic from 1968 to 1978 at the Faculty of Paris VIII (foreign literature, psychology, educational sciences, botany and clinical hypnosis), he completed his training in naturopathy in Germany (Heilpraktiker) and with numerous international experts (Naturopathic Osteopathy, Energetics, Yoga...) in the 1980s.

Co-founder of the French federation of Naturopathy (La Féna), he is currently vice-president and head of the national educational commission. He is President of the European Naturopathic Union and one of the representatives of the World Naturopathic Federation.

Naturopath, teacher, consultant, sophrologist and transpersonal psychotherapist, since 1976 he has led more than 2,000 conferences and internships in order to popularize the concept of integrative medicine, and especially the teaching of holistic natural health to which he devotes his life. He is the author of nearly 40 books on health and natural medicine.
